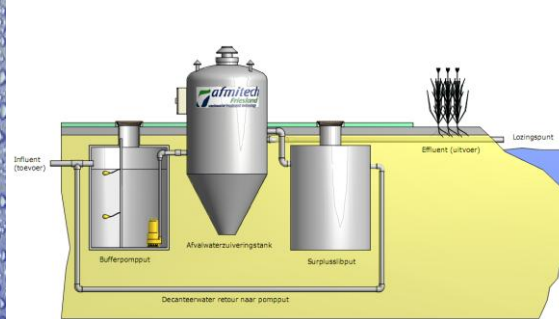


## Wastewater sanitation crematorium Lochristi (B)

### Project

The amount of visitors to the crematorium at Lochristi is varying, from very low to a peak of 3000 to 4000 man daily. By placing a decentralized wastewater treatment installation type Bever IIIA the fluctuations in the amount of wastewater can be treated in a normal way. This type of wastewater contains a lot of urine and has high nitrogen contents.



### Location

Lochristi is located on the east side of the city of Ghent in East Flanders and is part of the municipality Lochristi.

### Technology

The decentralized wastewater treatment system is mandated by our Belgian distributor Kebro NV Gruitrode Meeuwen (B), erected by Afmitech Friesland BV and consists of a treatment plant dug in with a diameter of 2.4 meters, a total height of 4.8 meters and sticks 1.5 meter above ground level. At busy days, this installation processes 13 m<sup>3</sup> of wastewater a day. Furthermore, an buffer pump sump and an excess sludge sump, who are completely buried are applied.
